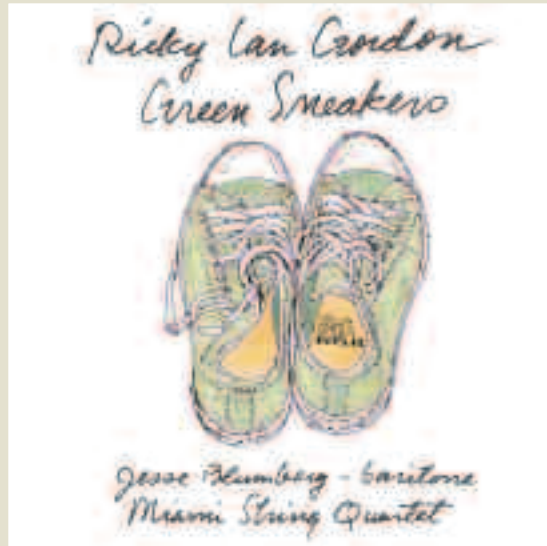

The Lights of Heaven, written in 1984-85 is one of the most distinctive works in Finnish music. A take on the age-old myth of how the sun was freed, it was composed as a commission from the town of Kaustinen. Based on the oldest myths and beliefs in archaic Finnish poetry, it has counterparts among ancient peoples the world over. In addition to a standard orchestra, the score calls for a childrens and mixed choir, soloists and a large selection of folk instruments.

So, what is Captain Jinks of the Horse Marines? Is it an opera? Yes, it is, but more specifically it is “A Romantic Comedy in Music.” Based on the play by Clyde Fitch, Sheldon Harnick wrote the libretto for this opera that was first performed in 1975 by the Kansas City Lyric Theatre. Born in 1921, Jack Beeson became interested in opera after listening to the Metropolitan Opera broadcasts and as a teenager wrote a five-act libretto. His interest in opera revived while teaching at Columbia University and he has gone on to write 11 operas as well as works for orchestra, concert band, vocal and choral groups and solo and chamber music. He is the MacDowell Professor Emeritus of Music at Columbia. This recording, originally issued on Columbia and long out of print, brings this delightful opera back to the catalog.

Her extensive catalog includes works written for the Houston, Shanghai, and Richmond Symphony Orchestras, the Saint Paul and Indianapolis Chamber Orchestras, American Ballet Theater, Pennsylvania Ballet and Jacob's Pillow Dance Festival. This recording highlights some of her enchanting music, including Bridges, a work for two clarinets and two Chinese instruments, the Erhu and the Pipa.

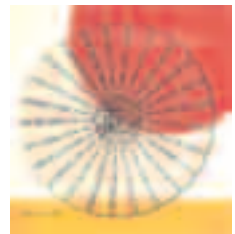

William Appling, who died in 2008, felt that the music of Joplin and Bach were perfect compliments to each other. He was passionate to have people hear that the two composers were comparable in the caliber of their work. Bach wrote tightly structured works within the baroque style and his music became more complex over time. Joplin worked the tightly structured rag style, developing and expanding it throughout his career. Both stylistically created music having melodies within melodies. These were two geniuses writing at the highest level and thus the idea for a recording pairing the music of both was born. Those people who heard William Appling play knew that his gifts as a pianist were equal to those as a conductor, teacher and mentor. This recording is a small sample of his genius.

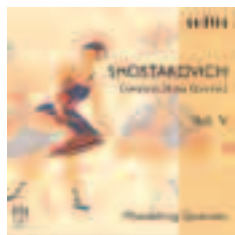

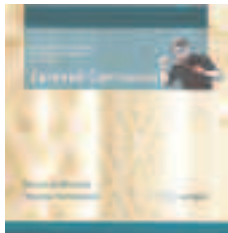

The Berliner Gramophone Co., which became RCA Victor (later BMG and Sony-BMG) is Canada's first record company. Emile Berliner started making records in Montreal in 1900. The recording business that at first sold a few thousands discs went on to sell millions. This disc features major recordings of Canadian Berliner and RCA Victor and the booklet includes the history of the company, the evolution of sound technologies and a social history of the milieu in which the company operated. The cd features an introduction by Oliver Berliner, grandson of Emile Berliner, the inventor of the phonograph. It also includes songs by the inventor himself and an illustrated 80 p. booklet on the history of sound recording in Canada.

Tom Johnson (b. 1939) belongs to a generation of American composers who founded musical minimalism. We know that this term was first applied to the visual arts, notably to Donald Judd, Robert Morris, and particularly Sol LeWitt, whom Johnson recognizes as an influence. However, it wasn’t the repetition in itself that interested him, but rather the idea of music as a process. Steve Reich applied this idea brilliantly in his phase pieces. But after 1975, while the same Reich distanced himself from the radicalism of his first works, and younger American composers came out with music that was lush, more expressive, even sentimental, Johnson insisted on the unrelenting rigor of formalized processes. The Rational Melodies, composed in 1982, may be regarded as the outcome of this research, first of all by their sheer quantity, but also by the fact that they summarize brilliantly and clearly procedures from the past, present, and future, which together characterize his work: combinations of cycles of different lengths (I, IV, XI, XVII, XVIII), permutations (VII, X), the paper-folding or “dragon” formula (II, XIX), other automata (XVI, XX), or self-similar structures (XIV, XV).

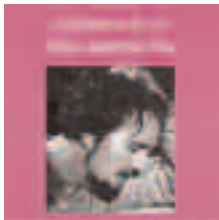

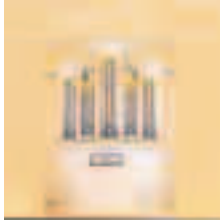

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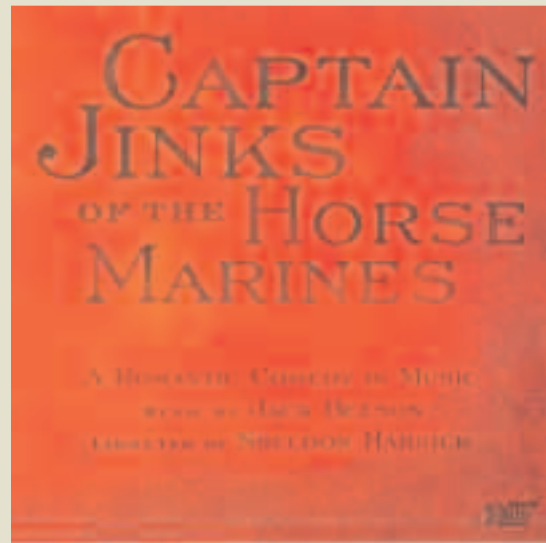
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
